The Bribery Act 2010: why is it important?

The Bribery Act 2010 came into force in the UK on 1 July 2011.

You can't afford to ignore it because:

- it carries significant penalties for individuals (*up to 10 years in prison*) and for businesses (*unlimited fines*)
- it has a global reach. UK individuals and businesses can be guilty of offences for conduct in any country
- your business can be liable for the actions not only of your employees, but also for the actions of agents, suppliers, customers, joint venture partners and others
- many ordinary and long-established business practices, particularly overseas, will now be criminalised

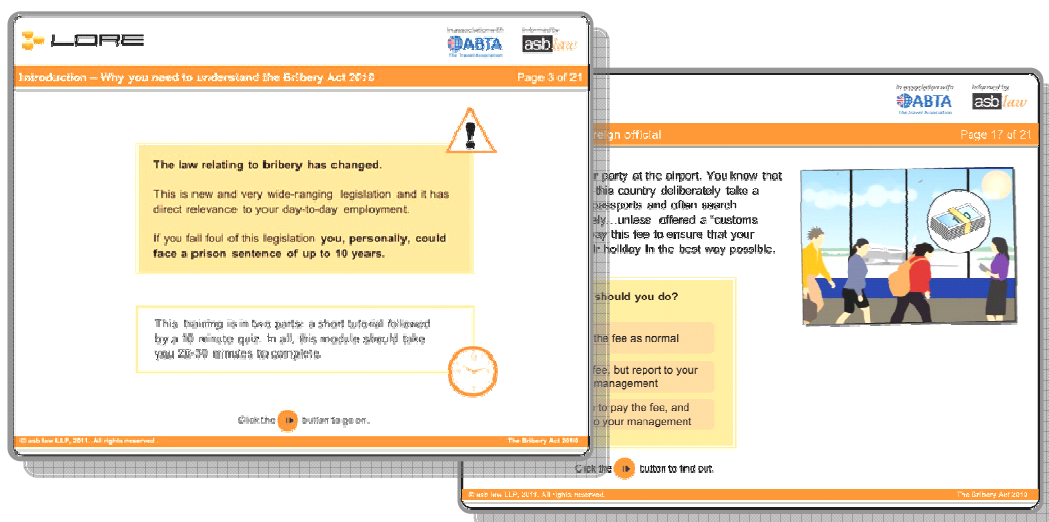
